Grantors

James Samford of Rappahannock County Planter and wife **Mary Samford**

Grantee

Quintan (Quintillian) Shereman of Rappahannock County

Terms

1400 pounds of tobacco and cask

Description

200 acres, part of a Patent to **James Samford**, near **Totoskey Creek**, adjoining land of **Edward Lewis** and **Roger Williams** (who purchased from **William Barber**), to have "without the denial of us ... or any person whatsoever only Indians excepted"

Mary Samford appointed **Thomas Freshwater** her attorney to acknowledge the sale
