One hundred acres in the County of Rappahannock and Parish of Farnham, near to Farnham Creek, commonly known as the Hoghouse land, and formerly belonging to **Capt. David Mansell** deceased; divided from the land of **George Howell** and **David Fristo** on the Eastermost side by a line of marked trees, and from the land that **Mr. Robert Baley** lays claim to which line runs on the Eastermost side of a path which goes from the abovesaid house to **Baley's** quarter, and running Northeasterly from the line which divides between the said house and **Peter Elder's** dwelling house almost to the said **Baley's** quarter
