

Deed Abstract: Joseph & Mary Elder land (1764)

Grantor

Joseph Elder and **Mary** his wife of Brunswick County, and **Richard Littlepage** and **Elizabeth** his wife of Dinwiddie County

Grantee

John Lamberth and **Jesse Jones** of Brunswick county

Date

25 June 1764

Terms

26 pounds 5 shillings and 6 pence current money of Virginia, "also for diverse other good causes and considerations"

Description

150 acres of land in the County of Brunswick; beginning on **Chamberlayn's** patent line on a branch the upper side of the said **Elder's** plantation thence up the said branch to the fork thence up the east fork to the head thence by a line of marked trees to **Centell's** line thence up **Centell's** ? several courses to a corner pine thence up the said line to a corner white oak thence by a line of marked trees including part of the land in **Henry Parrish's** patent to a corner white oak joyning of **Lamberth's** Hickory Run land thence up **Lamberth's** line to **Centell's** patent line to Black Jack corner thence along **Centell's** patent line to the dividing line of **Centell** and **Swanson** thence along the said line to **Samuel Chamberlayn's** patent line thence down the said line to the beginning; including 153 (sic) acres more or less with all buildings, gardens, orchards and other improvements
