This indenture made this ninth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine. Between Francis M. Petty of the County of Stafford of the one part and Joseph Elder of the County of Campbell of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds lawful Money of Virginia in hand paid by the said Elder unto the said Petty his heirs by their presents granted, bargained and sold unto the aforesaid Elder a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Campbell on the South side of Bath Creek (which on the waters Waters of Austins branch containing one hundred and forty four Acres more or less) and is bounded as following Beginning at Mitchells corner white Oak thence along his lines South six degrees West Seventy Chains to dead corner tree in sd. Mitchells Line thence by

Memorandum That on the day and year within written Every of
Seison was made, quiet and peaceable Possession was given of the within mentioned
tract of Lands by the within named Francis M. Colley unto the within
mentioned Joseph Elton according to the true intent and meaning of the within
mentioned Deed
