Marriage Bond dated 8 Dec 1797

Know all men by these presents that we Benjamin Wilson  
and Peter Wynne — are held and firmly bound unto James  
Wood Governor of the commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full  
sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to which payment well &  
truly to be made to the said Governor and his successors for the  
use of the commonwealth we bind ourselves our heirs execs &  
admitors jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed  
with our seals and dated this 8<sup>th</sup> day of Decr 1797

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas there  
is a marriage shortly intended to be solemnised between the  
above bound Benjamin Wilson & Ann Lanson —  
If therefore there be no lawful cause to obstruct the same then  
this obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and  
virtue
